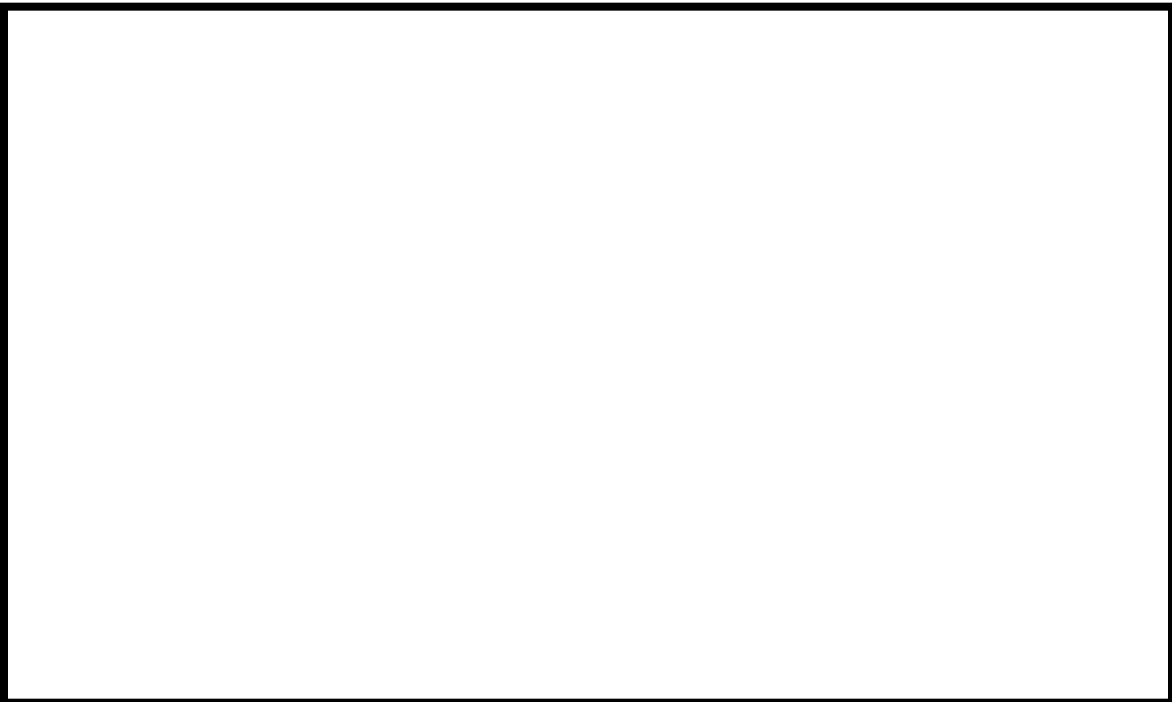

ARTFUL ARTIST: Your job is to create an artistic interpretation of the text your group is reading. Your interpretation should help you and your group members understand the text on a deeper level. You may choose to do any type of artistic response: draw an illustration, write a poem, song lyrics or music, or make a diorama, mobile or book cover. Your artistic interpretation can be about anything from the text: the characters, setting, conflict, conclusion or an important event. You could focus on a literary device used by the author or on sharing your inferences and predictions. Be creative and thoughtful. Think about how your creation will lead to deeper understanding of the text for both you and your group members. Regardless of what type of art you choose, you must first make an illustration in the box below. Use it to help plan your artistic response.

Show your art work to your group before telling them about it. Your group should look at it and use it as a springboard to discussion. Once all members have shared their thoughts, you can explain what you made, why you made it, what it represents and how it helps deepen your understanding of the text.
